Greetings with an introduction to our labor of love, *Wine in the Wild*, both a celebration and fundraiser. The Macon County Conservation Foundation gained stewardship of the historic Woodbine Farm near Dalton City. Under the care of the Penhallegon family for nearly 100 years, both the history and integrity have been preserved. Today we invite you to join us as we travail upon a community purpose for the farmstead. The property envelops a circa 1860s barn, several outbuildings, a historically registered Italianate style home, and a parcel of land. The Macon County Conservation District has been hard at work assessing, planning, and imagining the potential of the property.

The vision includes the addition of natural resources interpretive buildings, nature trails, restoration of farm fields to native prairie, and modernization of the barn to accommodate large events such as parties and weddings. The home, though well cared for, will require careful attention going forward to maintain its historic integrity.

As chairs of the planning committee, we are honored to introduce the Woodbine Farm to the community while honoring our Foundation's mission to restore and preserve Macon County's natural and cultural resources through the Macon County Conservation District and promote education about these resources.
